



# FIELD TECHNICIAN

Conduct inspections of oil and gas production sites, including permitted locations, production & injection wells, and associated facilities.

Document all inspections in the field activity database

Contact operators regarding violations of oil and gas laws and rules. Follow through to see that violations are corrected.

Communicate with District Supervisor and staff on compliance issues, and coordinate work with other inspectors.

Inspect reserve pits, plugged well sites to monitor and evaluate progress of reclamation.

Make inspections of permitted locations to screen for environmental concerns and reclamation requirements.

Inspect oil and saltwater spills and coordinate with the Reclamation Specialist on clean-up.

Witness various other procedures, such as well integrity tests, oil purchasing, etc.
