



PIPELINE ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN

Conduct inspections of oil, gas, and produced water gathering lines and associated facilities within the jurisdiction of the Commission.

Communicate with operators, contractors, independent inspectors, and surface owners regarding gathering pipeline rules and statutes.

Review gathering pipeline GIS data updates to determine inspection scheduling and locate gathering lines.

Respond to gathering pipeline leaks and coordinate cleanup with responsible party, surface owner, and reclamation specialist.

Inspect the construction, integrity testing, maintenance repairing, reclamation, and abandonment of gathering pipelines to ensure work is done properly.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High School Diploma/GED; a valid Driver's License; and experience with functions such as hydraulics, motors, pumps, pressure gauges, welding, or machinery.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS & KNOWLEDGE

Associate's degree with major course work in engineering, mathematics, and/or physical science; oil & gas experience; knowledge of GIS mapping software.

Knowledge of pipeline construction, repair, integrity testing, API (American Petroleum Institute) standards, and ASTM (American Society of Testing and Materials) standards is also preferred.
