

Public Fossil Dig - Pembina

-This dig is co-sponsored by the North Dakota Geological Survey, North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department, and Walhalla Economic Development. An excavation will be conducted at this site where fossils of mosasaurs (giant sea lizards), birds, fish, and squids have been recovered in past years.

-When: June 23 through June 29, 2014

-Where: Near Walhalla, Cavalier County

-Cost Per Day:

Adult: \$90 – ages 15 and up. Fee includes breakfast, lunch, snack, transportation to the fossil site from Walhalla, and souvenir.
