

# Public Fossil Dig - Whiskey Creek

-While you might call Medora a crocodile buffet, Whiskey Creek is the crocodile graveyard. This 60-65 million year old Bullion Creek Formation site was very swamp-like. It is in close proximity to the decade-long worked site called Wannagan Creek, made famous by the Science Museum of Minnesota. Each year we work at this site, the fossils get better and better. While other creatures can be found, crocodiles are by far the most numerous.

-When: July 12th - 14th, 2016

-Where: Near Medora, Billings County. Daily trips to the fossil site will originate from Medora.

-Cost: \$10 per person, maximum cost of \$25 per family. Participants must be at least 12 years old. Individuals under 18 years of age must have an accompanying adult. Lodging, meals, and transportation to the fossil sites are the responsibility of the participants.
