CENTRAL TANK BATTERY WELL TEST REPORT - FORM 11-sm AND FORM 11A-sm

1. This completed report shall be signed and witnessed and filed pursuant to Section 43-02-02.4-29 of the North Dakota Administrative Code (NDAC).
2. Wells shall be clearly identified by well name and number and well file number. The field, county, operator, well names and numbers, and file numbers shall coincide with the official records on file with the Commission.
3. All liquid volumes shall be reported as barrels (42 gallons) and rounded to the nearest full barrel. All gas volumes shall be reported as MCF. All oil and gas volumes shall be corrected to 14.73 psia and 60 degrees F.
4. All wells in a central tank battery shall be tested for a minimum of 24 hours or as provided for in field rules.
5. A separate report is required for each central tank battery. If additional space is needed, Form 11A-sm may be used.
6. If this is an amended report, the amended volumes shall be clearly indicated.
7. The original of this report shall be filed with the Industrial Commission of North Dakota, Geological Survey Division, 600 East Boulevard, Dept. 405, Bismarck, ND 58505-0840, within 30 days after the tests are completed.
