Summary of Work

Correlation and mapping of surface geologic units in North Dakota based upon outcrop and surface identification, shallow drilling, and interpretation of aerial and satellite imagery. Requires strong verbal and written communication skills and the ability to represent the Geological Survey to the public, industry, and other agencies. This position will require moderate to extensive fieldwork.

Minimum Qualifications

- A master's degree in geology.
- Effective verbal and written communication skills are essential.
- Ability to prepare technical reports of geologic studies for industry, government, and the public as well as publication in technical journals.
- Individual should be self-motivated.
- Applicant must have a valid driver's license.

Preferred Qualifications

- A background in geologic field mapping of glacial sediments or sedimentary rock.
- A background in geologic hazards (landslide) mapping.
- Experience describing and analyzing rocks and sediments in outcrop or in the laboratory.

- Knowledge of the geology of North Dakota or adjacent areas.
