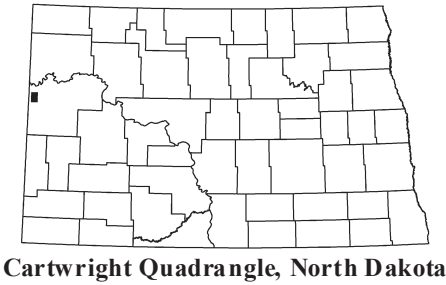
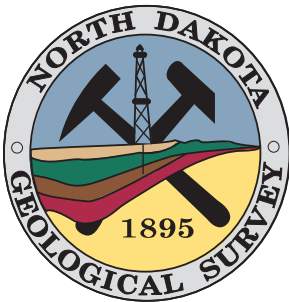
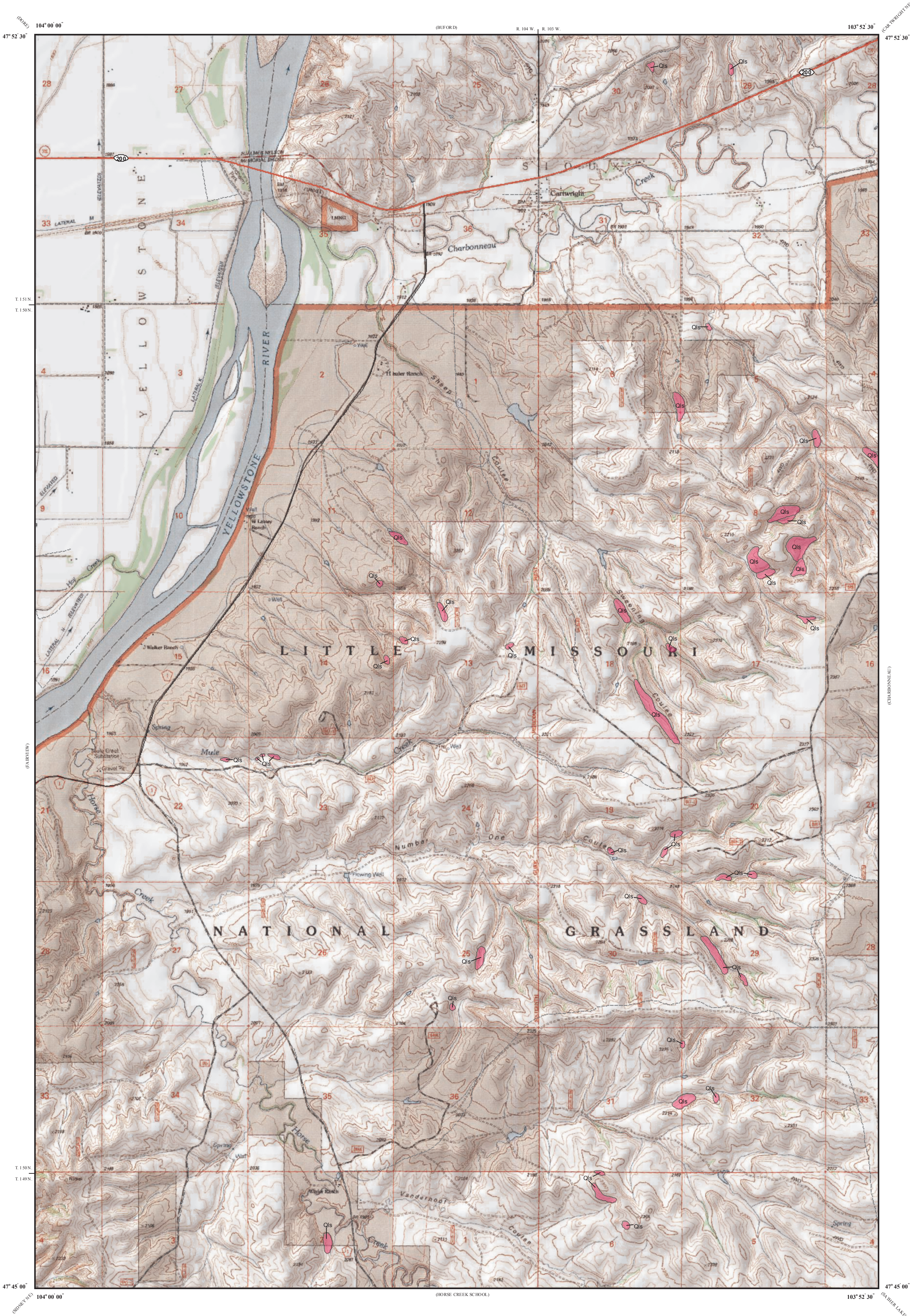
Known contact between two geologic units.
