Qls Landslide Deposits

Variable mixture of strata and deposits that have slid to the base of steep slopes. Most of the landslides in this area are hundreds, if not thousands, of years old.

Landslides identified on the quadrangle were mapped from stereo pairs, black and white 1:20,000 scale aerial photographs flown between 6-21-58 and 9-7-58. As a result these maps can be used to identify areas that are vulnerable to slope failure, but are not an up to date assesment of all landslides for the area.
