FIELD LIMITS, AND ENACT SUCH SPECIAL
FIELD RULES AS MAY BE NECESSARY.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

THE COMMISSION FINDS:

(1) This cause originally came on for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on the 28th day of August, 2008. At that time, counsel for Samson Resource Company (Samson) requested that the case be continued to the regularly scheduled hearing in September 2008. Order No. 12316 continued the case until September 25, 2008.

(2) Samson is the operator of all three wells currently completed in the Ambrose-Bakken Pool.

(3) Counsel for Samson requests that this case be continued to the regularly scheduled hearing in October 2008.

(4) There were no objections to said request.

(5) This case should be continued to the regularly scheduled hearing on October 23, 2008.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) This case is hereby continued to the regularly scheduled hearing on October 23, 2008.

(2) Commission Order No. 10971 shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commission.
