- 1. That it is the owner of an interest in the oil and gas leasehold estate in the SW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 163
 North, Range 92 West, Burke County, North Dakota.
- 2. That such lands are within the boundaries of the Short Creek Madison Field which is on a 160 acre spacing pattern, with prescribed locations to be in the SE 1/4 of each quarter section.
- 3. That applicant is of the opinion that a well drilled at the prescribed location may not be productive of hydrocarbons in commercial quantities, whereas a well drilled at the proposed exception location would be more apt to be productive of hydrocarbons in commercial quantities.

WHEREFORE applicant requests that the matter be set for hearing at the regular April 1980 meeting of the North Dakota Industrial Commission and that thereafter the Commission issue its order permitting the drilling of a well in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 163 North, Range 92 West, Burke County, North Dakota, as an exception to the spacing requirements for the Short Creek Madison Pool.
