- (2) That engineering evidence presented indicates that the reservoir discovered by the Kuntz #1-2 well is a single common source of supply and is separate from the Dickinson-Lodgepole Unit and the Eland-Lodgepole Pool (formerly the Knopik area). Therefore, the Commission should determine the temporary spacing and special field rules for the newly discovered pool.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That at the regularly scheduled hearing on June 28, 1995, the Commission will consider establishing temporary spacing and special field rules for the reservoir discovered by the Conoco #1-2 Kuntz well, located in the N/2 of Section 2, Township 139 North, Range 97 West, Stark County, North Dakota.
- (2) That this order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commission.
