- Case No. 8415: On a motion of the Commission to consider the application of Jordan Exploration Company, LLC, for an order establishing a 1280-acre drilling unit consisting of all of Sections 22 and 27, T.162N., R.94W., Burke County, North Dakota, and allowing a horizontal well with one or more laterals to be drilled thereon at any location not closer than 500 feet to the boundary of said drilling unit, or for such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
- Case No. 8416: On a motion of the Commission to consider the application of Zinke & Trumbo, Inc. for an order pursuant to North Dakota Administrative Code (NDAC) Section 43-02-03-88.1 authorizing the conversion to saltwater disposal into the Dakota Group of the Wolf SWD #1 well, located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 28, T.150N., R.102W., Foreman Butte Field, McKenzie County, North Dakota, pursuant to NDAC Chapter 43-02-05 and providing such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
- Case No. 8417: On a motion of the Commission to consider the application of Griffon & Associates, L.L.C. for an order amending the field rules for the Roosevelt-Bakken Pool so as to create and establish a 320-acre spacing unit for Michael Sharpio #32-15 well comprised of the E/2 of Section 15, T.142N., R.102W., Billings County, North Dakota, and/or such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
- Case No. 8418: On a motion of the Commission to consider the application of Aspen Energy Group Inc. for an order creating a 160-acre drilling unit comprised of the E/2 of the NW/4 and the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 34, T.138N., R.97W., Stark County, North Dakota, authorizing the drilling of a well within said drilling unit at a location not less than 660 feet from the boundary of the proposed drilling unit as an exception to the provisions of Section 43-02-03-18 of the North Dakota Administrative Code, and such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
