1. Form of Bids. Bids must be submitted on the enclosed bid form.
2. Submission of Bids. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, and the outside of the envelope must have the following on it:

3. Examination of Equipment. Prospective bidders are encouraged to make a visual inspection of the salvaged well equipment to ascertain the nature and condition of the equipment. Please contact Cody VanderBusch with North Dakota Industrial Commission (NDIC) Oil and Gas Division at 701-328-8020 to make arrangements to view the equipment. A partial listing of the equipment with estimated cost of tubulars is attached.
4. Terms of Sale. The Commission has title to all equipment on the sites and will provide a bill of sale to the successful bidder upon receipt of payment. Payment by the successful bidder must be in the form of cashier's check or certified check. All equipment is offered "as is" and there is no other expressed or implied warranty or guarantee.
5. Bid Deadline. All bids are due in the office of the NDIC Oil and Gas Division, by **3:00 p.m., September 21, 2018;** address: 1016 E. Calgary Ave., Bismarck, ND. Bids received after the deadline will not be considered.

6. Review of Bids. The public opening of the bids will be held at **3:00 p.m., September 21, 2018,** at the office of NDIC Oil and Gas Division, 1016 E. Calgary Ave., Bismarck, ND.
7. Withdrawal of Bids. Bids may be withdrawn by written request received prior to the time set forth in paragraph 5.
8. Rejection of Bids. The Commission, in its discretion may, reject any and all bids.
9. Notification of Bid Acceptance. The successful bidder will be notified of the award within ten days after the bid opening.
11. Cancellation of Bid Acceptance. The Commission may cancel the bid acceptance at any time before payment is received and accepted by Commission, without any liability to the Commission.
