INSTRUCTIONS

The original and one copy of a complete application must be submitted to the Oil and Gas Division. Be sure the form is complete.

This form must be accompanied by the \$100 permit fee and a pre-plot map displaying the proposed location of the seismic program lines.

No drilling or plugging operations shall commence until the Application for Permit to Engage in Geophysical Exploration has been approved.

Be sure that you have read and thoroughly understand the geophysical exploration rules and regulations, Chapter 38-08.1 North Dakota Century Code and Chapter 43-02-12 North Dakota Administrative Code.

An application for an exploration permit must be submitted to the Commission at least three business days before commencing operations.
